This Cookie Notice explains how LETS Consult EPA uses cookies and similar technologies on our website. It should be read alongside our Privacy Policy. We use cookies in accordance with the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Privacy and Electronic Communications) Regulations 2011 (SI 336/2011) and the GDPR.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work, to improve efficiency, and to provide information to the website owners. Cookies may be “session” cookies, which are deleted when you close your browser, or “persistent” cookies, which remain on your device for a set period or until you delete them. Similar technologies, such as pixels and local storage, may also be used, and we refer to all of these as “cookies” in this notice.

2. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies to help our website function properly, to understand how visitors use our website, and to improve your experience. We do not use cookies to collect information that directly identifies you unless you have provided that information to us, for example through a contact form.

3. Types of Cookies We Use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the website to function and cannot be switched off. They are usually set in response to actions you take, such as setting your privacy preferences or filling in forms. You do not need to consent to these cookies, but you can set your browser to block them, though some parts of the site may then not work.

Analytics & Performance Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting and reporting information anonymously, such as which pages are visited most often. This helps us improve the website. These cookies are only set with your consent.

Functional Cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make and provide enhanced features. They may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we have added to our pages. These cookies are only set with your consent.

4. Your Consent

When you first visit our website, you will be shown a cookie banner allowing you to accept or reject non-essential cookies. Strictly necessary cookies do not require your consent and will always be active. Non-essential cookies, such as analytics and functional cookies, will only be set if you give your consent. You can change or withdraw your consent at any time using the method described in Section 6.

5. Managing Cookies

You can manage your cookie preferences in the following ways:

- Using our cookie banner or preferences tool on the website.
- Adjusting your browser settings to block or delete cookies. Most browsers allow you to refuse or accept cookies and to delete existing ones. Please note that blocking strictly necessary cookies may affect how the website works.

Guidance on managing cookies in common browsers is usually found in the browser's "Help" or "Settings" menu.
